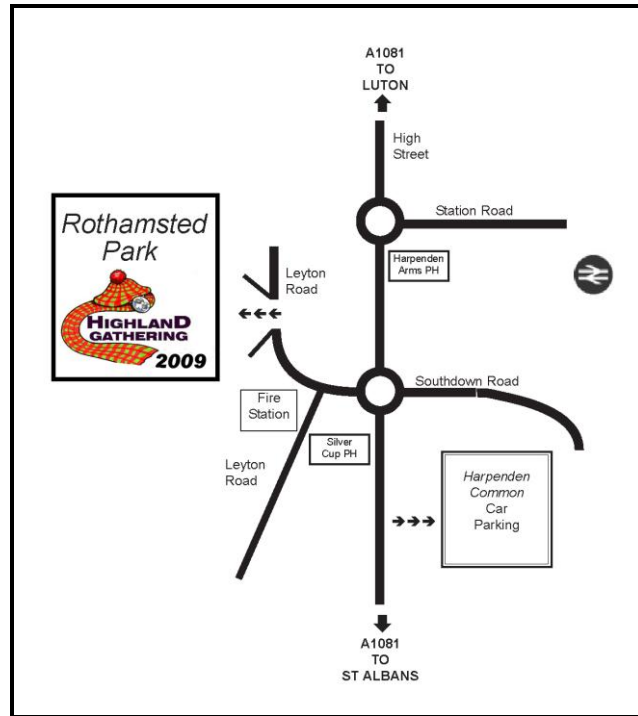




Harpenden Lions Highland Gathering

Sunday 12th July, 2009. Rothamsted Park, Harpenden AL5 2HU
10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.



The venue is Rothamsted Park, just south of Harpenden Town Centre. It is just a short walk from the Harpenden railway station on the St. Pancras / St Albans / Bedford line.

Access from the M1

Access from the M1 for both northbound and southbound drivers is best from Junction 9 – it avoids driving through the town centre. Rothamsted Park is about 4 miles from this junction. After leaving the motorway take the directions to Redbourn and St Albans in a southerly direction on the A5183. At the roundabout outside Redbourn take the first exit to Harpenden, B487. After the White Horse pub take the first exit on the roundabout going north; the next landmark is the Silver Cup pub. Follow signs or the directions of marshals to car parking.

Driving from St Albans

From St Albans go north on the A1081 in the direction of Harpenden, approximately 4 miles. Go across the first roundabout before Harpenden (signed left to B487 to Redbourn); the next landmark is the Silver Cup pub. Follow signs or the directions of marshals to car parking.

Alternative car parking

Rain preceding the event can make parking on the common impractical. You will be directed to surfaced car parking in Rothamsted Research Station.

Disabled Parking

Limited disabled parking spaces are available within the gates of Rothamsted Park. When you have shown your Blue Badge you will be directed to the parking area by the attendants. If there are no free spaces drivers you will be asked to set down at that point and will be given a pick-up pass to allow the driver to return to collect the disabled passenger(s) later.
