



Lions Clubs International European Musical Competition 2010/2011, Oboe

Young oboists are invited to apply for the well established Lions Clubs International European Musical Competition 2010/2011. Each Lions Club can sponsor one competitor to participate.

The instrument selected for the 2011 event is the oboe. Regional and national competitions select the one candidate to represent the UK and Ireland at the final in Maastricht, Holland, in October 2011.

The musician the club is looking for will be of a high standard, probably that of a music college graduate, be born after 31st December 1987 (23 or less) and will have been resident in the UK or Ireland for three years prior to 1st January 2011. One imposed piece and one other piece from the published repertoire list must be played.

The competition has three phases, each with a prize-winner:-

- 1. Lions District 105A finals**
Competitors from an area including London north of the Thames, Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire, Buckinghamshire and most of Oxfordshire. Venue likely to be Royal College of Music in January 2011.
- 2. Lions Multiple District 105 finals**
Winners from all the district finals in Great Britain and Ireland to select the one musician to represent the multiple district at the final. Venue will be the Birmingham Conservatoire in March/April 2011.
- 3. Lions European Final**
Winners from all the multiple district finals from each participating country. It will be a part of the Lions Europa Forum in Maastricht, Holland, 12th – 14th October 2011.

Entries should be sent to Harpenden Lions Club by 1st September 2010 at the latest enclosing a photo copy of the music to be played by the candidate.
